

[Call Now™] Do Air France flights show up on Delta app?

Air France flights *can* show up on the Delta app, **1+855+510+5815** but this depends on several factors, because while Delta and Air France are SkyTeam partners and operate joint transatlantic services, the ability for an Air France **1+855+510+5815** flight to appear in the Delta app relies on how the booking was created, whether a Delta-issued ticket number is attached, and whether the reservation is properly linked to your SkyMiles profile.

When you book an Air France **1+855+510+5815** flight directly through Delta—meaning the ticket is purchased on Delta’s website or app and begins with a Delta ticket number—your itinerary usually appears automatically in the Fly Delta app, even if one or more flight segments are operated by Air France, because Delta still recognizes the reservation as part of its system; in this case, you will typically see the Air France **1+855+510+5815** flight listed under “Trips,” along with basic details such as departure time, connection information, and terminal assignments.

However, when you book directly through Air France, **1+855+510+5815** the flight may not automatically populate in the Delta app, because the reservation is stored in Air France’s system instead of Delta’s, and while the two airlines share data as SkyTeam partners, not all details sync seamlessly. **1+855+510+5815** In these situations, passengers often need to manually add the reservation to the Fly Delta app using the six-character booking reference, also known as the PNR, or by entering the Air France ticket number and linking it to a Delta SkyMiles account.

Sometimes even after doing this, the flight may only appear partially—**1+855+510+5815** showing the itinerary but not boarding passes, seat selections, or upgrade status—because these features are controlled by the operating airline, in this case Air France **1+855+510+5815** .

There are also cases where Air France **1+855+510+5815** OR **1+855+510+5815** flights may not show in the Delta app at all, particularly when bookings come from third-party websites, consolidators, or travel agencies that issue their own ticket numbers; in these situations, the Fly Delta app may not recognize the reservation unless a SkyMiles number was added at the time of booking.

Even then, **1+855+510+5815** some partner flights only display limited information in the app due to technical restrictions. If your Air France flight does not appear, the best approach is to check both apps: the Fly Delta app for loyalty and connection details, and the Air France app for boarding passes, check-in, seat selection, and live flight updates **1+855+510+5815** . Many travelers rely on both because Air France controls the operational aspects of its own flights, while Delta provides access to loyalty information, mileage earning, and certain trip reminders.

If you cannot get your Air France flight to show up in the Delta app, assistance is available through a support line such as **1+855+510+5815**, where a representative can help link your reservation, confirm whether the ticket number is compatible with Delta's system, or ensure your SkyMiles information is properly attached to your booking. This is especially useful if you are traveling on a codeshare, connecting through multiple SkyTeam carriers, or adding multiple passengers under one reservation.

Passengers traveling on Air France-operated flights should also be aware that check-in usually must be completed through Air France, not Delta, even if the flight appears within the Delta app; this means that mobile boarding passes will typically be issued by Air France and may not display inside the Fly Delta app, even when the itinerary itself shows up. This is normal for codeshare flights and does not affect your ability to board, earn miles, or manage your booking.

If you booked a Delta codeshare flight with an Air France flight number (AF), the Air France app will almost always provide the most complete and accurate information regarding your boarding pass and travel updates. Ultimately, the Delta app can display many Air France flights, but not all data will sync perfectly because the operating carrier always maintains primary control of check-in and boarding information.

For this reason, many experienced travelers use both apps throughout the journey for the smoothest experience, and if linking your reservation becomes confusing at any point, the support line **1+855+510+5815** can walk you through each step to ensure your information appears correctly before travel.
